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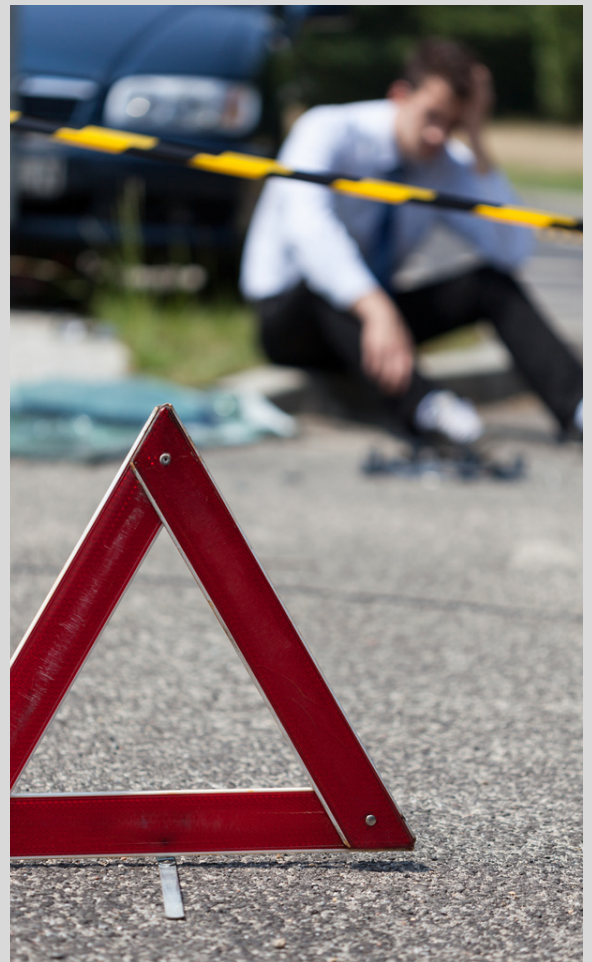
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YOU WERE IN A CAR ACCIDENT!

NOW WHAT?

1. If you have been involved in an auto accident in Tennessee and you have MedPay coverage on your auto insurance policy, it is important to notify your insurance company as soon as possible and provide them with any necessary documentation to support your claim. Your insurance company should be able to guide you through the claims process and help you understand your coverage and any limitations or exclusions that may apply

WHY YOU NEED CHIROPRACTIC CARE FOLLOWING YOUR CAR ACCIDENT?

In fact, data shows seeking chiropractic care first saves you time and money, and has a better health outcome.

IS CHIROPRACTIC CARE COVERED IN TENNESSEE AFTER MY CAR ACCIDENT?

In Tennessee, there are specific laws and regulations that govern chiropractic care for individuals who have been involved in auto accidents. For example, under Tennessee law, individuals who have been involved in auto accidents have the right to choose the healthcare provider of their choice, including our doctors here at Exodus Health Center. Additionally, Tennessee law requires auto insurance policies to include coverage for chiropractic care called Medpay.

DOES MY AUTO INSURANCE COVER CHIROPRACTIC CARE?

Medical payments coverage (MedPay) is a type of auto insurance coverage that is designed to pay for medical expenses that are incurred as a result of a car accident. In Tennessee, MedPay coverage is optional, but it can be a valuable type of coverage to have in the event of an accident. Check with your insurance provider to see if you have MedPay. One last sidenote of importance. You must seek care within one year of your accident to use your Medpay as the statute of limitations expires at the one-year mark from the date of accident.

WILL MY CHIROPRACTIC CARE COST ME MONEY FROM MY OWN POCKET?

If you have MedPay coverage on your auto insurance policy and you are involved in an accident, your insurance company will pay for your medical expenses up to the limit of your coverage, regardless of who was at fault for the accident. This means that you can receive medical treatment without having to worry about paying for it out of pocket, up to the limit of your coverage. In rare cases when Medpay is not available or policy limits have been met Exodus Health Center has special self-pay packages to make care very affordable!

WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING MY FIRST VISIT AT EXODUS HEALTH CENTER

Our office will ask that you fill out some forms required not only by us to help you but the insurance company you use, to make the process simple for you. Most of the time this can be done on your phone or laptop and submitted to us electronically. We will have a few forms at the office as well.

You will then meet with the Doctor to talk about your car accident and any injuries, discomfort, or pain you are dealing with.

Depending on the severity of the symptoms you will then receive a thorough examination of the muscles and joints and ligaments to determine what your body is dealing with.

If x-rays are necessary, they will also be taken at this time.

You may also receive your first treatment before leaving so you can begin healing and feeling better immediately.

We will have a second visit within 48 hours to go over the findings of your exam and explain the care plan the Doctor is recommending.

Reminder: Most of our clients have \$0 cost to them for these visits as the consultation and care is typically covered by MedPay (read above)
